The helicopters will be operated by EDIC Horizon International Flight academy. The agreement is part of the EDIC Horizon's plan to improve its portfolio to be in line with its client's expectations and meet their requirements by introducing twin-engine training courses.

EDIC Horizon have used Bell Helicopter aircraft since inception, and more recently had 4 Bell 206 helicopters added to its fleet in 2014 to reach 12 Bell 206 helicopters in operation.
